

Supporting Documents List

Indian Day Schools Class Action Settlement

When completing the Claim Form in-person, where possible, a Claimant should bring certain of the following supporting documents.

1. Evidence of school attendance:
 - a. Report cards
 - b. Enrolment forms
 - c. Class photographs
 - d. Letters from a teacher or principal
 - e. Yearbooks
 - f. School articles

2. Evidence of harm or abuse
 - a. Medical records
 - b. Dental records
 - c. Nursing records
 - d. Physical therapy records
 - e. Psychological therapy records
 - f. Narratives from family and/or friends
 - g. Photographs
 - h. Diaries

3. Documents relating to Powers of Attorney:
 - a. Court order
 - b. Other documents that demonstrates Power of Attorney over Claimant's finances

4. Documents relating to Executors / Administrators:
 - a. Death Certificate and a will
 - b. Revenue Québec Estate Form (if applicable)
 - c. Order or Grant of Administration from a court
 - d. Letters of Administration from INAC/CIRNAC

5. Any other documentation that may be relevant to your claim.
 - a. Personal I.D. (e.g., Indian status card, driver's license etc.)
 - b. Draft personal narrative

The list set out above is not an exhaustive list of all supporting documents that may be attached to a Claim Form. In certain cases, other supporting documents, not listed above, may also be helpful.
